Set-Up Times: Saturday, November 6, 6:00 am - 8:30 am

Space Rental: \$70 for each 8' x 8' space, \$10 for electricity, \$10 for table rental Open to anyone who makes a home crafted/handmade craft.

Distributors and vendors are **not** accepted.

General Information:

- Rental fee includes one 8' x 8' space and one chair. Additional chairs available upon request.
- Breakfast and lunch items will be available for purchase.
- Electricity will be available for an additional charge of \$10.
- Tables (approximately 6' x 2.5') are available for an additional charge of \$10 and must be reserved in advance.
- Special requests on the application form will be filled if possible.
- No concessions may be sold by exhibitors except pre-approved novelty or specialty food items.
- No sales of alcohol, firearms, weapons or animals are allowed.
- No raffles, games of chance, or gambling are permitted.
- No open flames are allowed except as pre-approved.
- To maintain a high-quality arts and crafts fair, sales of general merchandise or mass-marketed items are not permitted. If we see items that have not been hand crafted by the renter of the booth, you will be asked to remove those items. Failure to comply will result in being asked to leave the craft fair immediately.
- Eureka High School and Eureka Band Patrons accept no responsibility for lost or stolen items, accidents, or damages.
- Eureka High School is a smoke-free campus. Smoking will not be permitted.
- Deadline for applications is October 11, 2021. No refunds will be given after October 4, 2021.

Exhibitor Identification:

Car tags must be displayed in crafter vehicles.

Exhibitor's Responsibilities:

- Only merchandise listed on the application form may be displayed.
- All home crafted/handmade items displayed and sold must be made by the crafter renting the booth.
- Exhibitors may not play music at their booths.
- "Close-out" or "sale" items are not permitted.
- All exhibitors are responsible for setting up and dismantling their displays.
- Exhibitors are required to cover tables to the floor on all sides and keep packing material out of sight.
- All spaces must be cleared at the end of the day.
- Children brought by exhibitors must be strictly supervised.
- Booths must remain open until 4 p.m.
- Exhibitors are responsible for collecting taxes on their merchandise and reporting to the State.
- Exhibitors may not sublet or sell booths.

How big is your craft fair?

- We have room for over 150 crafters.

Will my booth be visible?
