UNIFORM DRY CLEANING INSTRUCTIONS

Each band member is **required to dry clean own band uniform**. Please have your uniform cleaned by following these steps exactly. Check off each step as it is completed, and return this form when you turn in your uniform.

- 1. Carefully remove baldric (sparkly sash) from front of coat, and store the baldric, gauntlets, and HANGER in your uniform bag. Do NOT take these to the dry cleaner.
- 2. The following dry cleaners are our recommended cleaners. *Please tell them that you are with the EHS Band and would like the group band price.*
- a) Westway Cleaners (207-0054)-all 4 locations: Ellisville (53 Clarkson Rd.), Des Peres (12032 Manchester Rd.), Rock Hill (9838 Manchester Rd), and Clayton (500 Hanley Rd). EHS Band Price: \$7.50
- b) Legends Cleaners (938-5677) Eureka, (54 Legends Pkwy., Suite 150). EHS Band Price: \$15.95
- 3. If you live outside the Ellisville, Wildwood, Eureka, Pacific areas and have difficulty taking your uniform to one of the recommended cleaners, then please have it dry cleaned at a trusted business near your house.
- Take only your band coat and pants to the dry cleaners. Do NOT take the baldric/sash, gauntlets, gloves, hanger, or uniform bag to the cleaners.
- 5. Pick up your uniform from the cleaners and **SAVE the RECEIPT**.
- 6. Replace the baldric/sash back on to your coat by velcroing and snapping it into place.
- 7. Clean out your uniform bag of all personal items (gloves, socks, ponytail holders, shoes, trash, etc.), leaving **only your gauntlets** in the uniform bag bottom pocket.
- 8. Place your **gauntlets and beret** (tuba players) in the **bottom zip pocket** of uniform bag.
- 9. Sign and date this form below.
- 10. Place this form (with dry cleaning receipt attached) in the *bottom pocket* of uniform bag.
- 11. Return your uniform on your ASSIGNED Uniform **Hanger** (with gauntlets, beret, this signed form, and dry cleaning receipt) and **HAT** to school on, or before due date on top of this form.
- 12. Do **NOT** return your shoes, gloves, lyre, socks, or trash in your uniform bag.
- 13. At school, hang your uniform on the rack that is labeled for **your GRADE LEVEL** NOT your normal rack.
- **14.** Place your hat (except for tuba players) on the **bottom of the same rack as your uniform. MAKE SURE YOUR NAME IS ON THE HAT BOX!**

CONCERT TUX DRY CLEANING INSTRUCTIONS

Each band member is **required to dry clean own concert tux**. Please have your tux cleaned by following these steps exactly. Check off each step as it is completed, and return this form when you turn in your tux.

- 1. Remove tie and cummerbunds from tux and store them in your tux bag. Do NOT take these to the dry cleaners unless they need to be cleaned. (\$2.00 per piece extra)
- 2. We recommend the following dry cleaners. *Please tell them that you are with the EHS Band and would like the group band price.*

Westway Cleaners – all 4 locations: Ellisville (53 Clarkson Rd.), Des Peres (12032 Manchester Rd.), Rock Hill (9838 Manchester Rd), and Clayton (500 Hanley Rd). EHS Band Price: \$9.30 for the pants, jacket and shirt.

- 3. If you live outside the Ellisville, Wildwood, Eureka, Pacific areas and have difficulty taking your tux to one of the recommended cleaners, then please have it dry cleaned at a trusted business near your house.
- 4. Take only your pants, jacket and shirt to the dry cleaners. <u>PLEASE HAVE THEM SPRAY</u> <u>THE COLLAR, UNDERARMS AND CUFFS of SHIRT!!!</u> You may also wash the shirt yourself and press it, or take to cleaners to be pressed. Do NOT take the tie, cummerbunds or uniform bag to the cleaners unless they need to be cleaned.
- 5. Pick up your tux from the cleaners and **SAVE the RECEIPT**.
- 6. Clean out your tux bag of all personal items (socks, shoes, trash, etc.).
- 7. Sign and date this form below.
